### Answer to the Certification Question

The correct answer is

Yes you may bring guests to the range. The restrictions are:

- 1) Members must remain with and supervise their guests.
- 2) The number of guests is limited to 2 at any one time.
- 3) The member can not shoot when the guests are shooting.
- 4) Guests are expected to share a bench with the member when the range is busy.
- 5) Guests are limited to 3 visits unless they reside at your address. If they reside at your address they may visit as many times as they wish.
- 6) The rifle range is closed on Friday, Saturday and Sunday to **all guests** for one month prior to big game season. This means guests are not even allowed on the range.

Explanation:

We try to encourage new membership by allowing you to bring guests. However these people have not been through certification and are most likely not familiar with our range rules. This is why we expect you to supervise your guests to ensure they are shooting safely and following our range rules. You obviously can not do this if you are shooting.

Also it is only fair that members do not have to wait for guests to finish shooting so they can have a bench. This is why we expect guests to share a bench with the member.

Guests are limited to a maximum of three visits so one member does not repeatedly bring his "buddies" to the range.

We try to encourage people residing at your address (Children and significant others) to come to the range so there is no restriction on how many times they may visit.

The reason guests are not allowed on the rifle range before big game season is simply because the range is so crowded. We have to give members priority to use the range first.
