### Talk is great but are you actively involved?

As sportsmen and firearms owners we must focus on protecting our 2<sup>nd</sup> amendment rights. It starts with voting Republican. Why the Republican Party, as opposed to the Conservative or Libertarian parties? ### Answer to the Certification Question

The correct answers to this question are A and B:

Explanation:

GCL has a no muzzle up rule. Your muzzle should never go above horizontal. The reason for this rule is we are located in the middle of a urban area in Penfield. If a round leaves any range it will land in a populated area. Panorama Trail runs behind the hill on the outdoor rifle and pistol ranges. Panorama plaza is across the street from the indoor range. All the ranges show damage from accidental discharges that have struck various parts of the ranges. Accidental discharges can happen to anyone inclining me and the ranges are set-up to minimize the likelihood of a round leaving. The most important thing is not to let the AD leave the range. However if your muzzle is pointed up your round will leave the range. So please keep you muzzle at or below horizontal.
